a longtime professor of ethnic studies at the university of california at berkeley ronald takaki was recognized as one of the foremost scholars of american ethnic history and diversity when the first edition of a different mirror was published in 1993 publishers weekly called it a brilliant revisionist history of america that is likely to become a classic of multicultural studies and named it one of the ten best books of the year now rebecca stefoff who adapted howard zinn s best selling a people s history of the united states for younger readers turns the updated 2008 edition of takaki s multicultural masterwork into a different mirror for young people drawing on takaki s vast array of primary sources and staying true to his own words whenever possible a different mirror for young people brings ethnic history alive through the words of people including teenagers who recorded their experiences in letters diaries and poems like zinn s a people s history takaki s a different mirror offers a rich and rewarding people s view perspective on the american story

takaki traces the economic and political history of indians african americans mexicans japanese chinese irish and jewish people in america with considerable attention given to instances and consequences of racism the narrative is laced with short quotations cameos of personal experiences and excerpts from folk music and literature well known occurrences such as the triangle shirtwaist factory fire the trail of tears the harlem renaissance and the japanese internment are included students may be surprised by some of the revelations but will recognize a constant thread of rampant racism the author concludes with a summary of today s changing economic climate and offers rodney king s challenge to all of us to try to get along readers will find this overview to be an accessible cogent jumping off place for american history and political science plus a guide to the myriad other sources identified in the notes
